In accordance with **ACC Rule 1.2**, the **Defender**, and the **Challenger of Record** with the approval of all other **Challengers** amend **ACC Rule 44.1(a) (ii)** as follows:

Original Rule:

44.1 Whilst racing:

- (a) the weight of the yacht without:
  - (ii) crew clothing

This rule shall now read:

44.1 Whilst racing;

- (a) the weight of the yacht without:
  - (ii) crew clothing including any standard equipment a crew person carries at all times while racing to fulfill their specific sailing duties (a non exclusive list of examples of permitted standard equipment are a pair of eyeglasses, a wristwatch, one pocket sized multi purpose tool, a knife, a roll of electrical tape, a hand bearing compass, and/or a climbing harness) unless the Measurement Committee determines any item is of unusual design and/or weight intended to confer a weight or measurement advantage"

Public Interpretation No 9 is rescinded.

This amendment may be reviewed upon the completion of Act 5 of the 32<sup>nd</sup> America's Cup. In the absence of any review this amendment shall remain part of version 5 of the **ACC Rule**.
