In response to the following:

1. *Are spreader end fittings described in 32.7 (b) considered to be part of the mast for the purposes of rule 13.1, Beam?*
2. *If the answer to question 1 is yes, in which position shall the spreader end fittings be positioned when measuring Beam?*

INTERPRETATION:

1. Yes
2. For the purposes of measuring Beam (rule 13.1), the spreader end fittings specifically shall be positioned as they were presented with the yacht in **measurement condition** (Refer Rule 43.1) .
