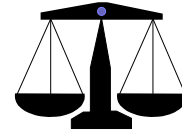

IN THE MATTER of the Protocol governing the 32nd America's Cup

AND

IN THE MATTER of an Application filed by Mascalzone Latino concerning the interpretation of Article 7(f)(ii) of the Protocol.

Jury Decision - Addendum

- [1] On the 21st April 2006 the Jury delivered its decision in respect of this case, ACJ014.
- [2] Mascalzone Latino has noted that the decision delivered does not contain the name of Gabrielle Kaufmann-Kohler as a Juror signatory.
- [3] The reason for this is that on the 20th April 2006, approximately 19 hours prior to the release of the decision, Gabrielle Kaufmann-Kohler tendered her resignation as a member of the America's Cup Jury. Such resignation was unrelated to matters concerning this case.
- [4] All five members of the Jury participated in all matters concerning this case up until the 20th April 2006. This participation included the drafting of the decision.
- [5] In particular, those parts of the decision that relate to "*place of construction*" (paragraphs 20, 21 and 23) and "*breach*" (paragraph 24), were agreed by all five Jury members prior to Gabrielle Kaufmann-Kohler's resignation.
- [6] As a result of Gabrielle Kaufmann-Kohler's resignation shortly before the release of the decision, her name was not then included. The Jury considered that notwithstanding such resignation, having reached a decision in terms of the Protocol, it was appropriate to still release the decision. All of the then remaining members of the Jury were accordingly recorded as a signatory to the decision.
