Following is a summary of the meetings and deadlines scheduled over the next several days prior to the commencement of the Finals of the Louis Vuitton Cup.

Please ensure that the relevant people are informed and attend, as required.

Flag Meetings will be held in the Jury Hearing Room of the Edificio Varadero.

Flag Meetings for the Semi-finals of the Louis Vuitton Cup:

31 May Thursday 1000 Flag Meeting for the Captains of the two (2) *bona fide* Spectator Boats of each Finals Competitor and all AC Management boats permitted inside the Race Diamond (including Foredeck Boats, TV Commentary Boat(s), and Press Boat).

As per the Terms of Challenge, each Competing Competitor (Challenger) is permitted to apply for two (2) of its *bona fide* Spectator Boats to be permitted inside the Race Diamond during racing in the Finals.

The authorized representative of each Finals Competitor and the Captains of the two (2) vessel nominated to be flagged inside the Race Diamond shall attend a meeting with the Course Marshals and Race Committee as above.

The Captains and "pilots" of the Foredeck Club boats used by AC Management, the TV Commentary Boat(s), the Press Boat, and a representative of AC Management shall also attend this meeting with the Course Marshals.

**31 May Thursday 1130 Flag Meeting for Captains of other *bona fide* Spectator Boats
of Competitors and all other AC Management authorized
boats to be flagged.**

As per the Terms of Challenge and the advice of AC Management by Email on 30 April, each non-Competing Competitor now is permitted to apply for up to two (2) Flags for its *bona fide* Spectator Boats; and

Each Competing Competitor may also apply for a third flag (in addition to the 2 issued above) for a third *bona fide* Spectator Boat.

An authorized representative of each Competitor and the Captain of each vessel that a Competitor nominates to be flagged shall attend this meeting with the Course Marshals.
